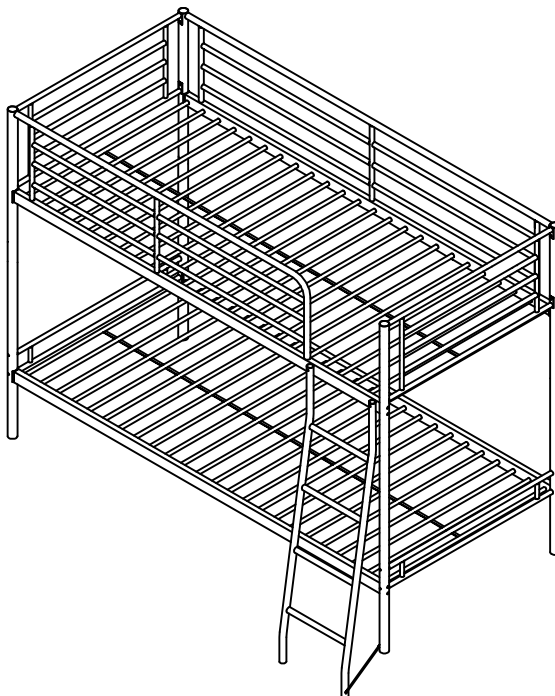


BRANDON BUNK BED ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

IMPORTANT NOTICE

SAFETY WARNING

- The upper bed of the bunk is not suitable for children under six years of age due to the risk of injury from falls.
- Strangulation Hazard-never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed: for example, hooks, belts, cords and harness ect.
- The recommended mattress size for this bunk bed is 6' 3" x 3' x 6" (1900mm x 915mm x 150mm).
- The maximum mattress thickness is 6".
- The maximum mattress height is clearly marked on the bunk and **MUST NOT BE EXCEEDED**.
- Children can become trapped between the bed and the wall. To avoid risk of serious injury the distance between the top safety barrier and the wall shall not exceed 75mm or shall be more than 230mm.
- The bunk bed should not be used if any structural part is broken or missing.
- Assemble on a soft clean surface.
- Do not use any tools other than those shown.
- Any spanners or Allen keys required are included with the fittings kit.
- Do not for any reason use a power tool to assemble this product. Its use will invalidate any claim you may have and could make this product unsafe.
- Assembly fixings should always be tightened properly and care should be taken that no fittings are loose.
- Depending on the amount of use this product receives it may be necessary to tighten up the fixings from time to time. This is completely normal for any flat pack furniture. **DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN FIXINGS.**
- Two persons required to assemble this product.
- For cleaning you may use a damp cloth(not wet)
- This bunk is manufactured to conform to BS EN 747-2012











Method of Cleaning

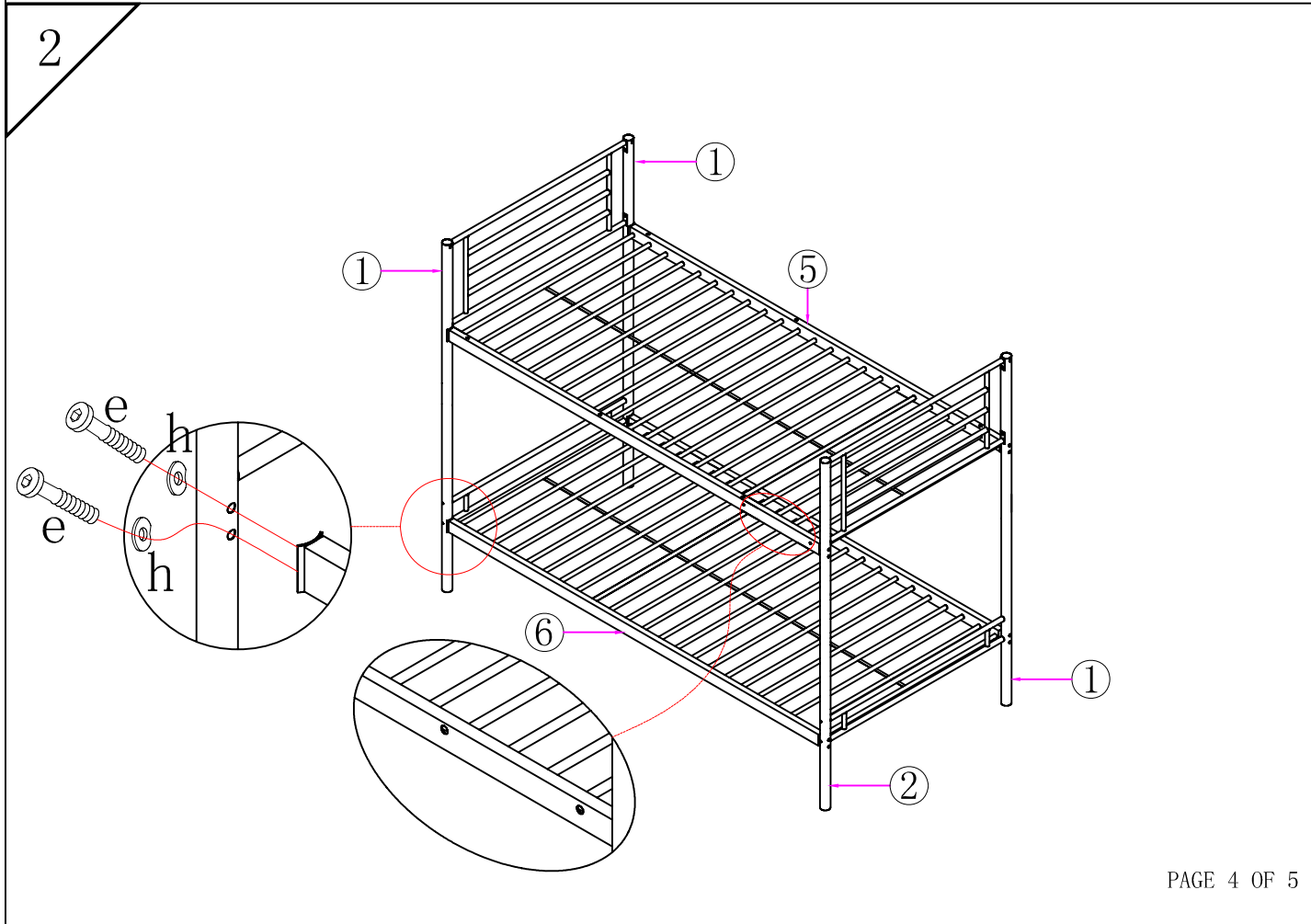
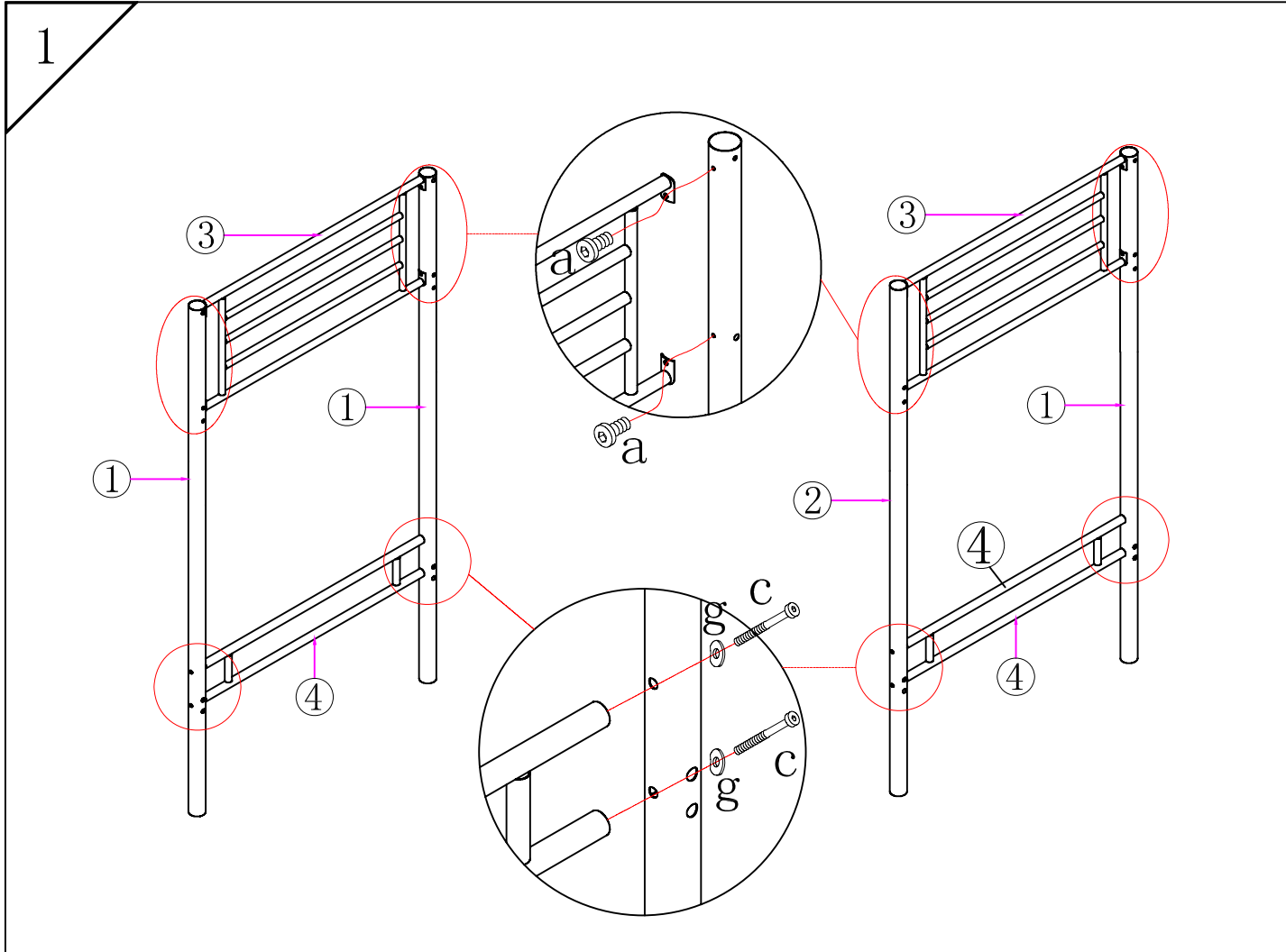

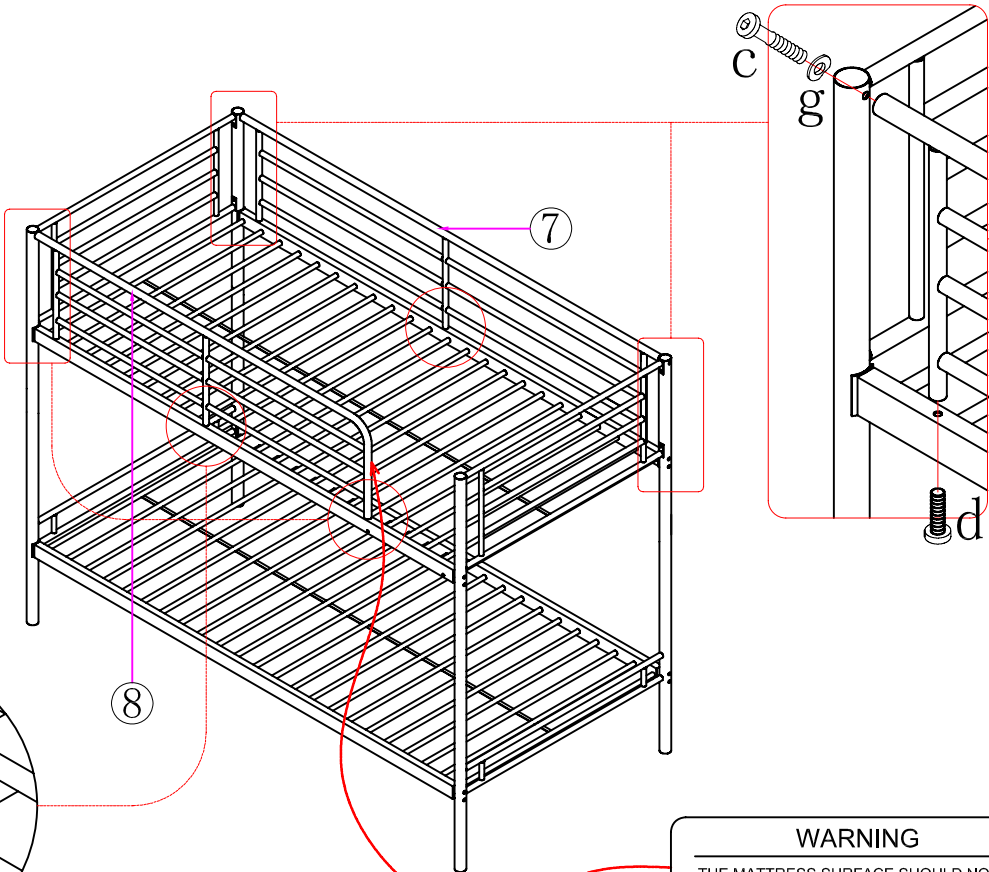
